Boy, just 20 months old, gets attention for his drumming

BLOOMFIELD HILLS, Mich. Julian Pavone beats a mean drum -- and he's not even two years old.

The 20-month-old boy from Bloomfield Hills, Michigan, has played at a Cleveland Cavaliers game and has recorded a C-D with Cavs' drum coordinator William Winfield the Third and jazz bassist Ralphe Armstrong. Armstrong calls Julian a genius who plays like a reincarnation of Buddy Rich.

Julian's dad Bernie Pavone has been a drummer for more than 30 years and says he discovered his son's natural talent when the child was only three months old. He was practicing with the infant in his lap and says his son kept trying to grab the sticks, so he took Julian's little hands and they played together.
